Rules of using nouns

1. **After** a number 數字 (WS P.1)
e.g. He has five pencils.
2. **Before** a verb 動詞 (WS P.2)
e.g. Our shirts are white. noun + be + noun
3. **After** a verb 動詞 (WS P.10)
e.g. He is Gary.
4. **After** a, an, the (WS P.3, 13)
e.g. She is a monitor.
5. **After** a possessive pronoun (WS P. 16-19 + refer to the chart)
e.g. These are his trains.
6. **After** phrases of quantity (WS P.7)
e.g. I have two boxes of chicken wings.
7. **After** some, a lot of , any (WS P.20)
e.g. There are some sandwiches.
8. **After** an adjective (WS. P. 22)
e.g. He has big eyes.

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Rules of using adjectives

1. After a verb 動詞 (WS P.22,23,24)

e.g. He has big eyes.

noun + be + adjective

2. After a noun 名詞 (WS P.22-23)

e.g. The king has long legs.

3. After very / really / too (WS P.21)

e.g. Ben is very shy.
